Germany: a new 3D sand printer is used for the first time in European foundry



Novel hybrid process chains expand classic mould making to include the advantages of 3D printing. The Blöcher foundry is the first company from Europe to use a new 3D sand printing system. However, the new machine will not only be used in the Blöcher foundry for the rapid production of moulds for the production of spare parts and small series made of aluminium. The robot-assisted system is also used when urgent replacements are needed for defective, worn or lost tools for deep drawing, foaming, rotational moulding, thermoforming or blow moulding.

Bangladesh: BSTI brings 43 new items under licensing



Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution (BSTI) has brought some 43 new products under mandatory licencing to ensure availability of quality products in the market. The firms will have to put BSTI standard mark in the labels, packages or containers of the products. The BSTI, an organisation under the ministry of industries, issued a gazette notification, dated January 31, 2021, with the names of the products. Rotationally moulded polyethylene water storage tanks are included among the products.

Spain: Familycash owners buy Plastiken

The Albiñana family, which founded Plastiken, maintains ownership of Vondom, the designer outdoor furniture brand that for years has operated as an independent company from the company with which they started in plastics molding business. Germany: a specialist in plastics processing celebatres its 50th year of blow molding



A decision made 50 years ago was the starting point for specializing in plastics processing methods for Roth Industries, a company based in Dautphetal-Buchenau. Although heating oil tank production boomed until the end of the 1990s, Roth started manufacturing water and

clarification tanks using the blow molding process as early as 1994. The experience gained in tank production was used here. Later, the rotation process was added as a production method for containers with a capacity of up to 6000 liters. (Translated from German)
