Polar Fishing Gear boost its innovative trawl doors 28/01/2022



Polar has developed an innovative approach to opening fishing nets that will have positive environmental impacts on the marine ecosystem. Pluto is a remotely controllable fishing door made from recycled plastics. Designed for large fleets of small fishing boats, Pluto uses rotationally moulded plastic materials, which improves the hydrodynamics of ships and helps reduce fuel consumption.

New ambitions for a French manufacturer of rotomolded and custom-made planters

In August 2019, Lionel Joire bought Green City, a thirty-year-old company based in Clermont-Ferrand, in France, that specializes in planters and other outdoor plant furniture. Past the storm of the health crisis, Lionel Joire has ideas for development. Green City designs and markets two families of products: planters and other furniture manufactured in rotational molding (using steel molds, owned by the company, but located at the subcontractor's in the Rhône-Alpes region), made of polyethylene plastic and which generate 60% of the turnover. He is thinking of other outlets in the event industry, for example logos or giant letters for companies. The company will create a specific structure for this activity and a dedicated website for marketing. (Translated from French)

Toter's new cart is made of 100 percent recycled material



<u>Toter's</u> new EVR-Green cart body is made of 100 percent recycled material. Manufactured with a variety of recycled materials and entirely without the use of virgin resin, the two-wheeled cart is, according to Toter, the first fully recycled cart body and fully recyclable cart on the market. The roto-molded design helps to minimize the built-in stress, weakness, and brittleness associated with injection-molded waste containers typically found in the marketplace.

Tank Holding, said to be North America's largest rotational molder, has acquired Wisconsin-based rotomolder Dutchland Plastics LLC for an undisclosed amount. Dutchland makes high-volume rotationally molded products including kayaks, coolers, playground equipment, and furniture at manufacturing sites in Oostburg, Wis., and Canastota, N.Y.
