<u>Development, control, and monitoring of foam produced during rotational moulding</u>



Rotational foam mouldings provide increased buoyancy and mechanical properties, which are beneficial for lightweight marine structures. For optimal performance, appropriate material and process parameters must be used. However, establishing these for large products is challenging. The work aimed to develop processes and procedures to enable the optimisation of foam structures for large-scale lightweight rotationally moulded multi-layer products.
