<u>Reprocessed Materials Used in Rotationally Moulded Sandwich Structures for</u> <u>Enhancing Environmental Sustainability: Low-Velocity Impact and Flexure-after-Impact Responses</u>



In the rotational moulding industry, non-used, scrap, and waste purge materials have tremendous potential to be reprocessed and applied in skin-foam-skin sandwich structures to replace and reduce the use of virgin polymers. This approach not only encourages the re-use of these waste materials but also significantly contributes to reduce environmental impacts associated with the use of virgin polymers in this sector.

Mesoscale modelling of polymer powder densification due to thermal sintering



A mesoscale model is proposed for the density evolution of an initially low density polymer grain powder which becomes compacted by heating above its melting point. There are two main contributions. First, we present a rigorous generalization of the Mackenzie and Shuttleworth model to predict the density evolution of a porous representative volume element containing multiple spherical cavities of various sizes. Second, we propose a novel development linking the evolution of the sintering angle in the two-grain models of Frenkel and Bellehumeur et al. to the density of a set of multiple interacting grains.
