## Method for the production of a reinforced thermoplastic container



An internally reinforced thermoplastic container has a body manufactured using rotational molding. Prior to molding, attachment elements are releasably attached to the interior surface of parts of a mold, and an initially separate tension member is connected between the attachment elements. The mold is closed and a body of the container molded such that the attachment elements are integrated into the walls of the body.

The installation Animate Concrete by the Digital Design Unit (DDU) of the TU Darmstadt for the Dutch Design Week 2022 in Eindhoven consists of robotically manufactured hollow components whose shape and mass distribution enable kinetic behaviour. Solid-looking but lightweight hollow bodies made of concrete and an acrylic resin-mineral powder composite are produced using the so-called rotomoulding process. (News in German)
