Also molded into the base is a tubing channel interconnecting the air pump and an air stone positioned centrally in the bottom of the container.

Animal feeder



An animal feeder including a container for containing feed, a lid and a feeding trough. The container being rotationally moulded in one piece and having an open top through which feed can be delivered into the container and which is closable by the lid . A lower passage is provided for delivering feed to the feeding trough, the lower passage being defined between a sloping base of the container and a lower side wall of the container.
