<u>Identification of damages into a polymer structure by AE - transition from tensile specimen to structure</u>



This paper aims to study the damage mechanisms with acoustic emission technique (AE) in a polymer sandwich structure that contains three layers: two polyethylene skins and the polyethylene foam core (skin-foam-skin). First, a classical tensile test was carried out to correlate the acoustic signals with plasticity initiation and damage of a polyethylene sample. The results obtained are similar to those observed in other studies. Moreover, it is possible to separate the signal due to cavitation from the signal due to necking propagation.
